STACK Collection is comprised of two moulded trays; No. 5 and No. 7, in ash wood, inspired by the traditional Shaker bentwood boxes from the mid-eighteenth century.

STACK reference sheets of paper by its crisp structure and curved overlapping surfaces, playing on the great qualities of wood, being both structurally strong and delicate. Like the traditional Shaker boxes, STACK trays nest inside each other and interact sculpturally. When stacked, a new design dimension appears.
